



SOL Offers Fourth Performance

TEHRAN -- The celebrated SOL trio music band has offered its fourth performance, Shadi (gaiety), to the market, news reports have said.

The new works, composed of performances by several well-known musicians, is performed by three violins. It is of better quality compared with the previous ones. Bahman Mahabadi, player of the first violin, is a permanent member of Tehran Symphonic Orchestra with widespread cultural activities. The second violinist, Housman Behzadi, has learned music in the SOL Institute and is now studying in Canada. Poursya Keshavarz, the third violinist, would in the near future unveil his skills. Shadi presents patterns from 800 years of the world music dating back to the Middle Ages and Renaissance period. The group is now working on its fifth work, composed of three violins and one lute. Mahabadi says the group would perform every two months in the new Iranian calendar year (starting March 21). Mehrshad Hakim-Shafaie, coordinator of SOL group, has given an upbeat assessment of the performances, saying the group is turning the spotlight on the executive affairs.
