

Sole Group At European Event

TEHRAN, Dec. 24--

An Iranian music group, known as Sole, took part in the European Music Festival which is underway in Romania from Nov. 26 with the performance of several songs including a piece of song by Henry Purcell.

The public relations director of the group, Homa Sadr Arhami told Iran Daily that the international music festival was held to mark the centenary of the founding Craio Philharmonic Orchestra.

Major European music groups including Italian symphonic orchestra also took part in the festival.
